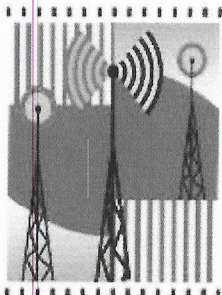

2. **Approval of December 2025 Meeting Minutes**

3. **Approval of December 2025 Bills** – Braudis advised normal bills there were extra expenditures for recertifications and costs for Staffing/Wellness Summit in February for Supervisor staff. This two day conference brings PSAP leaders from across the country together to discuss best practices, whats working and new ideas in the industry.

4. **Budget FY26 / State Submission** – Braudis reviewed the budget stating as is Decembers vote to publish as is. Since this time, discussion took place with RACOM and with impending costs for radio console (end of life replacements) and the paying of three years maintenance into one year a cost savings of 5% was provided at a total of \$31,332.95. Discussion involved reducing line 18 of budget to reflect accurate amount of \$595,326.00.

5. **MCEMSA Information Sharing** – Phil Summers and Kim Elder advised remaining information was completed for the grants needed three months early, all goals were met that were need as an association. Upcoming conference, no further updates.
